District Facilities Community Advisory Team

On September 27, a team of sixteen residents and staff members met to discuss Marshall Public Schools District facilities. Meeting participants became familiar with the 2022 Building & Grounds Study Team's recommendations and reviewed the current facilities needs such as: increasing the safety of each school's entrances, Elementary School window replacements, renovating the High School Tech Education classrooms, Elementary School roof replacement, upgrades to the softball fields and football/track complex, and parking lot repairs. Participants engaged in discussions, shared questions, and provided guidance by prioritizing the list of facility needs.

Mrs. Kristin Wilkinson, School Business Manager, shared a wealth of distinct financial information regarding District funds, student enrollment, revenue limit, potential tax levy, and anticipated mill rate. Advisory Team participants and the District created a short Facilities survey that will be sent to each resident across the district in October. Residents are strongly encouraged to share their feedback for the Advisory Team, District Administration, and the Board of Education to consider when planning future facility replacements.

Interested residents are encouraged to participate on October 25, from 6:30 - 8:30 pm, in the District Office boardroom. All are welcome. Participants will reflect on the resident Facility survey feedback, consider project costs while determining potential funding sources, and plan to provide recommendations to the Board of Education in December.
