## **Marshall Board Selects Daniel Grady as New Marshall District Administrator**

The Marshall Board of Education has completed its extensive search for a new superintendent to succeed Dr. Barbara Sramek upon her retirement in June. Daniel E. Grady, Ed.D. has been selected from a pool of 46 applicants. The selection process included recruitment and candidate recommendations from School Exec Connect, the district's search firm, multiple interviews by the school board, and engagement sessions with staff and community members. Dr.

Grady's contract, effective July 1, 2018, will be formally acted on by the Board of Education at a meeting in the near future, pending the finalization of contract details.

Dr. Grady's administrative experience includes his current position as the elementary school principal in Fall River, WI; elementary school principal, preceded by intermediate associate principal in Milton, WI from 2011-2017; and middle school assistant principal, preceded by high school assistant principal in Mount Horeb, WI from 2006-2011. Prior to his career in educational administration, Dr. Grady served the Marshall school district in several capacities, including interim athletic director, choral music teacher and athletic coach, preceded by similar assignments in Burlington and Waterford school districts.

Dr. Grady earned his doctorate and district administrator licensure from Edgewood College. He completed his master's degree and principal, curriculum and instruction licensure through Aurora University and his bachelor's degree through UW-River Falls. He is a graduate of Marshall High School and resides with his family in the Marshall School District.

Strengths that emerged through the interview process and feedback from staff and community members include Dr. Grady's roots, commitment and passion for Marshall; his approachability and willingness to connect with students, staff, parents and community members; and his breadth of leadership experiences across all educational levels, the arts and athletics.
