**SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS**

The Board of the Marshall Public School District derives its legal status from the Constitution of the State of Wisconsin. The Board acts as an agent of the state in developing an educational program in accordance with the state Constitution and state and federal laws.

The Board of Education shall consist of seven (7) members, with all members being elected at large. Each member of the Board is elected for a term of three (3) years, except as otherwise provided by law.
