LEGAL COUNSEL

The Board of Education may appoint an attorney at its discretion to advise and represent the district in all matters requiring legal counsel. The school attorney shall serve in an advisory capacity to both the Board and the District Administrator.

A decision to seek legal advice or assistance on behalf of the district shall normally be made by the District Administrator. Such action shall occur as it is consistent with approved district policy or standard practice and meets an obvious need of the district.
