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## **SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS**

A special Board meeting shall be held upon the written request of any Board member. The request shall be filed with the Board Clerk or, in his/her absence, the Board President.

Board members shall be notified of the time and place of the special meeting at least 24 hours prior to the meeting, in accordance with state law. A special Board meeting may be held without prior notice if all Board members are present and consent, or if every Board member consents in writing even though he/she does not attend.

All special meetings of the Board shall be open to the public. The Board reserves the right to meet in closed session in accordance with state law.

Notice of special Board meetings shall be given to the public in accordance with state law and established procedures.
