**CLOSED SESSIONS**

Except as otherwise specifically provided, the Board shall conduct all business in open session, which the public may attend. The Board may meet in closed session only for the purpose of discussing matters specifically authorized by state law. Before the Board goes into closed session, the Board President shall announce to those present the nature of the business to be considered at the closed session and the specific exemption(s) under law by which the closed session is authorized.

Notice of closed sessions shall be given to the public in accordance with state law and established procedures.
