-SERIES 100 BOARD OF EDUCATION

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BOARD COMMITTEES

The Marshall Board of Education shall act as a committee of the whole with the exception of the following standing committees:

- Curriculum & Instruction
- Buildings, Grounds and Transportation
- Finance and Long-Range Planning
- Negotiations and Policy
- Legislation and Advocacy

Standing committees shall be appointed annually by the Board President. The Board President shall consider term of office and preferences from the individual Board members in making appointments. All standing committees shall consist of at least two members of the Board. All appointments shall become part of the official minutes of the regularly scheduled June Board meeting.

Standing committees shall schedule meetings monthly or as needed, in accordance with established procedures. Standing committees shall report back to the full Board and discussion and findings.

Temporary committees may be appointed by the Board President. The committee members shall elect a chairperson(s). The duties and purpose of a temporary committee shall be outlined at the time of appointment and the committee shall be considered dissolved when its final report is made and accepted by the Board. Temporary committees shall schedule meetings in accordance with established procedures.

Except as specifically directed by the Board, standing and temporary committees shall act only in an investigatory and advisory capacity and shall have no power to take action whatsoever, or to commit the Board or district to any course of action.

The Board President and the District Administrator shall be advisory members to all standing and temporary committees of the Board.
