PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

Meetings of the Board of Education are held for the expressed purpose of conducting the business of the school district. The Board welcomes citizen attendance at Board meetings and shall schedule time at the beginning of each regular meeting for members of the public to speak before the Board.

The Board may limit the time allotted to an individual speaker's comments to three minutes. Discussion of personnel matters or challenges to instructional materials used in the District will not be allowed. The Board may not discuss or act upon any item of business not included in the public notice of the meeting, except as specifically authorized by law. After all appropriate communications have been received and persons heard, the Board will proceed with the business of the meeting without further communication or participation by the audience members except as requested by the Board President.
