BOARD-SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONS

The Board shall organize and maintain the distinction between those activities which are appropriate to the Board as the legislative governing body of the district, and those administrative activities which are to be performed by the Superintendent and his/her staff in the exercise of a delegated administrative authority.

The Board believes that the development and enforcement of policies is its most important function, and that the execution of the policies should be the function of the Superintendent. Delegation by the Board of executive powers to the Superintendent provides freedom for the Superintendent to manage the district within the Board's policies and to administer the day-to-day operations of the district.

The Board shall hold the Superintendent responsible for carrying out its policies within established guidelines and for keeping the Board informed about school operations.
