READING INSTRUCTION GOALS

The Board of Education believes instruction in reading is a basic skill and supports the following reading goals for the district:

- 1. A coordinated developmental reading program shall be made available for students at all grade levels and shall be under the direction of the building principal.
- 2. A variety of learning materials and teaching techniques shall be used to accommodate individual student ability and achievement.
- 3. Cooperation between parents/guardians and the school shall be strongly encouraged to facilitate each student in reaching his/her potential.
- 4. Interventions and services shall be provided for students who may be in need of such services.
- 5. Monitoring and evaluation of the reading program and student achievement in reading shall be conducted on an annual basis.
