**READING INSTRUCTION GOALS**

The Board of Education believes instruction in reading is a basic skill and supports the following reading goals for the district:

1. A coordinated developmental reading program shall be made available for students at all grade levels and shall be under the direction of the building principal.
2. A variety of learning materials and teaching techniques shall be used to accommodate individual student ability and achievement.
3. Cooperation between parents/guardians and the school shall be strongly encouraged to facilitate each student in reaching his/her potential.
4. Interventions and services shall be provided for students who may be in need of such services.
5. Monitoring and evaluation of the reading program and student achievement in reading shall be conducted on an annual basis.
