## SERIES 300 INSTRUCTION

## PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

The Board of Education shall provide programs and related services for students with disabilities as defined by state law. Such programs may be provided in cooperation with other school districts in accordance with established agreements.

Within the parameters of state and federal laws governing the operation of programs for students with disabilities, there are due process procedure safeguards for parent rights and appeal. Such provisions shall be adhered to by the district. The district's special education handbook shall be revised regularly to reflect changes in state or federal law or Department of Public Instruction directives.

The Director of Pupil Services shall be the coordinator of Section 504 activities in the district.
