**TALENTED AND GIFTED SERVICES**

The district shall strive to offer each student experiences appropriate to his/her individual needs, interests and capabilities.

Talented and gifted (TAG) services shall be established to provide the potentially high achieving student with instructional programming that best meets his or her needs.

“Talented and gifted students” shall include those students who give evidence of high performance capability or interests in one or more of the following areas of giftedness: intellectual, creative, artistic, leadership or specific academic areas. The components of such services may include, but shall not be limited to, curriculum modification, acknowledging diversity and providing flexibility within the classroom structure to allow for enrichment opportunities and the provisions for systematic and continuous services.

Students shall be identified as talented and gifted in accordance with state guidelines.

The Board shall review the talented and gifted program on a regular basis.
