## SERIES 300 INSTRUCTION

## TITLE I PROGRAMS

In order to meet its goal of providing educational opportunities for all students of the district, the Board shall participate in the federal Title I program.

All programs and services provided for Title I students shall be at least comparable to those provided in areas not receiving Title I funds. Also, the district shall ensure equivalency among schools or grade levels within the district in teachers, administrators, auxiliary personnel, curriculum materials and instructional supplies. When determining comparability, the district need not consider unpredictable changes in enrollment or personnel assignments which occur after the beginning of the school year.

The Board recognizes the importance of parent/guardian involvement in the Title I program and, therefore, shall provide appropriate opportunities for parents/guardians to become involved in the design and implementation of the district's program.

Specific activities for parent/guardian involvement in the district's Title I program shall be developed. These activities shall be reported to the Board on a regular basis.
