HIGH SCHOOL GRADING SYSTEM

At Marshall High School, grade point averages shall be calculated using one of the following methods:

Point values ranging from 0 to 4. An assessment of 2 or greater is required to earn credit for a class.

- 0 – No Evidence
- 1 – Needs Improvement
- 2 – Basic
- 3 – Proficient
- 4 – Exemplary

Starting with the graduating class of 2011, in conjunction with the Laude Recognition process, the GPA calculation will be determined by multiplying cumulative student GPA at the end of the 1st semester of the senior year by the total number of advanced courses taken throughout four years of high school.

Laude Recognition Ranges:

Cum Laude	13.6 to 22.1
Magna Cum Laude	22.2 to 30.3
Summa Cum Laude	Greater than 30.3
