## **ASSESSMENT PROGRAMS**

An assessment program shall be established and maintained in the district in order to:

- 1. Evaluate the total educational program of the district. The District Administrator, along with the Director of Instruction, with assistance from the professional staff, shall develop standards and procedures to evaluate the educational program and student progress within each area of instruction.
- 2. Provide better counseling services to students of the district.

The district's assessment program shall include all assessments required by state law and/or regulations.

Decisions regarding the inclusion or exemption of students in the district's assessment program shall be made on an individual basis in accordance with established procedures.

Marshall Public Schools shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for testing, evaluating and counseling students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
