SENIOR CLASS TRIPS

The senior class may organize and take a senior class trip, in accordance with the following criteria:

1. The trip shall not cause participating students to miss more than two days of school.
2. At least half of the senior class agrees to go on the trip.
3. The cost of any tour involving a set fee shall be paid by individual participating students. Additional fees may be paid from senior class funds.
4. The cost of any chaperone fees not covered by the tour agency will be paid from class funds. Each chaperone will be paid for personal expenses incurred during the course of the class trip.
5. Planning for the trip, including student and parent financial commitment to the trip, must be completed by December 1st of the school year in which the trip is to be taken.
6. The trip, whether in or out of state, must be approved by the School Board at the December Board Meeting.

Students not participating in the senior class trip are required to attend school during the days of the trip.
