The Board endorses the concept of student exchange programs and encourages student education/travel in other countries as a means of promoting better understanding of the world we live in.

The high school principal or designee will review the academic record of each prospective exchange student to ensure that the student will meet graduation criteria in a timely manner. Students must have completed their sophomore year, earned at least 13 credits and have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.6.

Credit toward graduation requirements will be in accordance with established procedures.
