Administrative Rule 354

GUIDELINES FOR FOREIGN STUDY PROGRAMS

The high school principal may grant up to seven credits for one year's study abroad using the following guidelines:

1. Up to 1.5 credits per semester in the language of the host country if it is other than English.
2. Up to 1.5 credits per semester for independent studies in a non-English speaking country/school. The areas of study will be determined in advance of the student's departure and appropriate assignments will be made by the high school teaching staff or the University of Wisconsin Extension – High School Studies Division.
3. Full credit will be considered for any courses taken in the host country provided:
 - a. a course outline and/or syllabus is made available,
 - b. a passing grade is received, and
 - c. the course is not a repetition of any that the student has taken previously.
