**INTERNET POLICY**

Students in the Marshall School District may have access to and use the Internet at school in accordance with established guidelines. Each student wishing to use the Internet shall be expected to sign an agreement (363.3 Exhibit) and to abide by the Internet use guidelines. Internet agreements shall be signed and returned to the building principal/designee prior to the start of the school year. This agreement is valid for the time the student attends that school. An Internet agreement must be on file in the building where the student attends prior to the student being allowed to use district computer equipment and to access the Internet using district equipment.

Student use of the Internet shall be viewed as a privilege, not a right. School Internet accounts may be used for educational and research purposes only, consistent with the educational objectives of the District. The network administrator or his/her designee will monitor Internet usage in accordance with board policy and established guidelines.

Misuse may result in loss of Internet use privileges and school disciplinary action. Appropriate legal action may also be taken against students who violate the Internet use guidelines.
