## SERIES 300 INSTRUCTION

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## **GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAMS**

A guidance and counseling program corresponding to the needs of the students shall be developed and maintained to provide counseling, assessment/evaluations and information services to all students. The program shall be developmental in nature and be part of an integrated approach to student services.

Whenever deemed appropriate and necessary, the district shall engage services of professional consultants such as psychologists and social workers to work with the district counselors.

Marshall Public Schools shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for counseling, evaluating and testing students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
