ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS OTHER THAN OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS

Students who are not residents of the district may attend schools in the district on a tuition basis, with the approval of the Board. The Board shall make a written agreement with the student's parent/guardian, another school district or an agency for the payment of tuition. Tuition payments shall be calculated in accordance with state law. Transportation of nonresident students shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian, except as provided for students with disabilities.

The Board is not required to enroll a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another school district. If such a student seeks to enroll in the district, the Board may request the school board of the former district to provide it with the following information: (1) a copy of the expulsion findings and order; (2) a written explanation of the reasons why the student was expelled; and, (3) the length of the term of the expulsion.

Tuition Waivers

The Board shall permit a student who has gained 12th grade status and is a resident of the district at the time of gaining such status to complete the 12th grade without payment of tuition, even though he/she is no longer a resident of the district.

A student who was a district resident on the third Friday in September or the second Friday in January of the current school year and who has been enrolled in the school district for at least 20 school days during the current school year shall be permitted to complete the current school year at the school he/she is attending without paying tuition, even though the student is no longer a school district resident.

A student who is a resident of Wisconsin and to whom all of the following apply shall be permitted to attend school in the district in the current school year without paying tuition:

1. The student was a resident of the district on the second Friday in January of the previous school year;
2. The student was enrolled in the district continuously from the second Friday in January of the previous school year to the end of the school term of the previous year; and
3. The student ceased to be a resident of the district after the first Monday in February of the previous school year.

A qualified foreign exchange student may be enrolled and attend school in the district without charge if he/she is recommended by the American Field Service or an approved organization and are staying with a family living within the boundaries of the district.

A student who is a resident of the district at the beginning of the school year may complete the school year without payment of tuition, even though he/she is no longer a resident of the district.

The Board, or designee, may allow a nonresident student to enroll in district schools and waive the tuition requirement if the student's parent/guardian establishes residence in the district within nine school weeks.
