STUDENT COUNCIL

A student council may be organized in any school within the framework of guidelines adopted by the building principal and his/her faculty representatives.

The function of a student council shall be to provide a channel of communication between students and the professional staff of the building. Self-discipline is a goal of education. A functioning student council composed of conscientious students can be of great value to a school in cultivating responsible student conduct.

The Board recognizes the contributions students can make to the development of policies governing their own conduct. However, those regulations and policies shall always remain the province of the Board and administration.
