STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Specific rules and regulations regarding student behavior on school buses shall be developed by the administration and reviewed annually by the bus contractor and the Board of Education. Approved rules shall be distributed to each student annually.

Bus drivers shall report student behavior problems to the building administrator in writing using the appropriate form. Bus drivers are encouraged to work out potential behavior problems with students and/or their parent(s)/guardian(s) and the bus contractor prior to referring students to the building administrator. Students shall never be put off the bus to walk home or to walk to school.

Students who refuse or fail to comply with bus rules or regulations may have their bus riding privileges taken away. Suspension from the bus may be ordered by the building administrator. Such action shall normally follow conferences by the building administrator with the student, the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) and the bus contractor. Exceptions may be made under extreme circumstances. If a student's bus riding privileges are suspended, notification of the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) and due process shall be in accordance with state law.
