STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

The purpose of the district's health program will be to supplement the efforts and guidance of parents to bring an awareness on the part of students of regular health care.

The district will:

1. Promote good health habits among students.
2. Provide a sanitary and healthful environment in the schools.
3. Assist in detecting and recommending correction of medical, psychological, and physical handicaps of students.

Physical health records will be maintained on all students and will be confidential. These records will be released only to persons entitled to them by Wisconsin State Statute or to other persons with the informed consent of the student's parent or guardian or the student if over 18 years of age. Pupil health records will not be maintained for a period of longer than one year after the pupil ceases to be enrolled in the school.

Immunizations

Students must be properly immunized against certain communicable diseases as specified by law prior to admission to elementary school. Immunization requirements may be waived for an individual student for health or religious reasons.

Physical Examinations

Students must have a physical examination and present a medical certificate stating that the student is in good physical health prior to initial admission to school.

Annual Screening

Vision and hearing screening will be planned and administered in cooperation with the Dane County Health Department.
