STUDENT MOTOR VEHICLE USE

Rules and regulations concerning student-driven vehicles, in addition to state motor vehicle laws, shall be established by the building principal. Motor vehicles should not be used during school hours unless special permission is given by the High School Principal.

Student use of the school's parking facilities should be considered a privilege. All student motor vehicles parked on school property must be registered and approved by the administration. Students shall park their vehicles in designated areas and shall abide by all established parking regulations.

Appropriate safe speeds and observance of pedestrians and safety regulations are expected. Failure to comply with established regulations may result in suspension of parking privileges.
