STUDENT FEES, FINES AND CHARGES

FEES:

The Board recognizes its responsibility to provide a total educational program for students in the district. The Board further recognizes that certain activities, courses and services may require additional funding and, therefore, may charge student fees accordingly. If the District determines that a student is experiencing financial needs, it may choose to provide any or all such materials free of charge. Any student under particular financial need may appeal to the building principal for a partial or full deferment of such fees. The District and the parent, guardian or student may agree to a payment plan in an effort to collect on outstanding fees over time.

The fees charged shall be reviewed annually and adjusted when necessary. A notice of the fees charged shall be available prior to the beginning of the school year. Student fees are assessed at the beginning of the school year or at the time of admission into the district, school or class.

FINES:

Fines shall be assessed when school property is abused or lost. The fines shall be in direct relation to the damage or loss, taking into consideration the normal life of the property.

Any fees for fines collected by members of the staff shall be turned into the school office/secretary within twenty-four (24) hours of collection.

When necessary, the administration may take appropriate action to collect outstanding fees or fines including the use of small claims court or a collection agency.
