STUDENT ACTIVITY FUNDS MANAGEMENT

All income and receipts from student activities such as dramatic productions, student government, etc., fall under the responsibility and control of the Board. Even though student groups may undertake activities to raise this revenue, these funds are, nonetheless, considered to be district funds. In all circumstances, the Board, or its designee, has authority to determine the manner in which these funds will be disbursed.

The board designates the Superintendent or his/her designee, to oversee the operation and proper maintenance of the student activity accounts. The Superintendent, or designee, as an extension of the Board, shall authorize expenditures within the student activity accounts.
