BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS INSPECTIONS

Safety inspections are one of the principle means of determining possible causes of accidents before they cause injury. Inspections should not be limited to search for unsafe physical conditions, but should also include examination to detect unsafe practices.

The Board shall request periodic safety reviews from its insurance carrier and shall attempt to comply with its recommendations. In addition, district facilities shall be inspected at least annually for potential or demonstrated hazards to safety and health. Hazardous conditions shall be corrected, compensating devices installed or special arrangements made to provide for safe and healthful facilities.
