## **INJURY/ACCIDENT REPORTING**

The Marshall Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing for the safety and wellbeing of students and employees while they are at school or are participating in school activities.

All student and staff injuries occurring in school, on school premises or at a school-sponsored activity shall be reported to the building principal or his/her designee. The Superintendent shall be notified immediately in the case of an injury that requires major first aid treatment. Student injuries that are of a serious nature shall be reported to the student's parent(s)/guardian(s). Injuries of which parent(s)/guardian(s) are notified shall be noted on the emergency services log by the caregiver.

An accident report shall be completed following a student or staff accident occurring in school, on school premises or at a school-sponsored activity that results in the student or staff member missing class or work time, being absent from school or work, requiring the services of a physician or requiring first aid, or, if the accident may be cause of liability at a later date.

Costs resulting from accidental injuries which are not covered by individual or family insurance policies shall not be the responsibility of the district.
