EMERGENCY PLANS

The administration shall develop an Emergency Response Plan which shall provide as much protection as possible for children while at school and on their way to and from school, and should provide adequate training to students and staff so that the school emergency plan may be carried out with the greatest possible speed and safety.

The Superintendent, or designee, shall ensure the existence of emergency plans for evacuating the buildings during fire and other emergencies, for using the buildings for shelter in the safest manner possible during extremely inclement weather and for dealing with other emergencies such as hostage situations or the presence of armed individuals on school premises. Drills shall be held to practice emergency plans.
