STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The District's policies, rules and regulations for the transportation of public and private school students to and from school shall be in compliance with state law and regulations.

While the law requires the District to furnish transportation, it does not relieve parents/guardians from the responsibility of providing for the supervision of their child until such time as the child boards the bus and after the child leaves the bus at the end of the school day. Once a child boards the bus, and only at that time, he/she becomes the responsibility of the District. Such responsibility shall end when the child is delivered to the approved bus stop at the close of the school day.

The Business Manager or his/her designee, in collaboration with the transportation provider, will be responsible for establishing bus routes and schedules of the transportation services provided to the students attending Marshall Public Schools.

In addition to providing transportation to and from school, the District may provide public school students with transportation to and from school-approved co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
