SERIES 800 SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

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PUBLIC USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Board encourages the use of school facilities by district residents and community organizations.

Requests for use of school buildings and grounds during such times that the buildings or grounds are not required for school purposes may be granted to any responsible resident of the district or any responsible community organization that has named an individual to be in charge of the activity.

Some restrictions are necessary to protect the schools and school equipment which in reality belong to all the people of the community. Therefore, the Board shall approve detailed regulations pertaining to public use of school facilities. Residents and community organizations wanting to use school facilities shall request permission from the Activities Secretary who shall then refer the application to the Building Principal and District Administrator for final approval. Full responsibility rests with the resident or organization to maintain adequate security and to leave the facilities in the same condition as they were before usage.

The Board may establish rental charges and nominal fees to cover the costs of labor, heat and light.
