Marshall Elementary School is a Title I School-wide school. This means that our school receives federal funding to support high quality instruction and improve academic achievement. We use these additional funds to provide instructional coaching and interventions for teachers and students.

Our Title I goals in the coming year are to:

- Integrate Common Core aligned reading, writing, and communication into all subjects
- Integrate technology to support high quality instruction in all subjects

Along with data collected by teachers in the classroom, we will continue to use Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Exams (WKCE) to measure our progress toward our goals. In addition, third and fifth grade students will participate in a mid-year District Writing Assessment. These assessments inform our practices and help us continuously improve.
